


Get Involved

To get involved in the **ARTES Community of Practice** is as simple as to click on the **“Sign Up”** button on the **Home page** and insert your user name, password and a few details in the window that shows up.

In the Home page you can see **10 small boxes related to various arts.**



By clicking on them you can read and send your messages to participate in the debates related to the kind of art shown on each box (e.g. debates on topics related to 'Theatre' as an art for social inclusion and education); you can also initiate a debate on a topic of your interest in the relevant box.

The **3 big boxes** at the bottom page "**School Education**", "**Adult Learning**", "**Vocational Education and Training**" contain a repository of European Union funded projects in the framework of the LifeLong Learning Programme, on the use of the arts for social inclusion and education.



The projects' products here included were created by multicultural partnerships of European professionals and were tested in a variety of countries in Europe. They have a clear European dimension and can inspire you in your work and interests.

In the last box '**Learning Paths**', the ARTES core group members aim to upload selected practices with detailed description that you can use/ adapt in your own environment and contexts.
